CIRCULAR WALK THROUGH RESLAW WOOD.

Approx length 2 miles

Leave the Hall heading away from the Church on the B4221 to Oak Lane on your right.

Turn here & walk uphill for approx 1/4mile to a footpath sign on your left.

Take this path (keeping the wood on your right) passing over a bridge & stile.

Turn immediately right over another stile heading diagonally left uphill following the way mark signs. At the top of the first rise look out for a way mark sign pointing right. Continue in this direction keeping the wood on your left crossing 3 stiles & following the way mark signs.

Look out for a stile on your left into the wood.

Cross this stile & turn left heading downhill.

Depending on the time of year there is quite a show of wildflowers on this section.

Walk downhill through some recent coppicing until you come to a way mark post.

Bare left to a bridge & gate.

Turn left & immediately left again to a gate.

Pass through this gate & keeping the wood on your left pass through 1 more gate until you reach the stile & bridge you passed earlier in your walk. Retrace your steps to the village hall.

This walk can be muddy through Reslaw Wood.
